

■ NOTE: For identification purposes, it is necessary to refer to only the last six digits of the vehicle identification number.

Condition:

It has been determined that existing Gasline Hose (p/n 0610-016) between the gas tank and the fuel pump was incorrectly routed and secured to the driven shaft protector bracket. This incorrect positioning will cause the hose to wear against the bracket resulting in severe damage to the hose. See Fig. 1 for the improper routing and positioning of the hose.

Solution:

Inspect all affected snowmobiles to determine if the gasline hose is improperly routed and secured to the driven shaft protector bracket.

■ NOTE: To obtain easy access to the gasline hose, it is recommended that the air silencer assembly to moved forward.

If the hose is improperly routed and secured (see Fig. 1), remove the gasline hose from the cable tie.

■ NOTE: When the hose is properly routed and not secured to the bracket, the hose should lie under the steering post and along side the air silencer assembly (not underneath).
